

Statement on Helping Refugees on the Polish-Belarusian Border August 30, 2021

For several days we have been witnessing a crisis on the Polish-Belarusian border, where several dozen people, refugees from the Middle East, suffer from hunger, cold and indifference. We cannot look at their suffering with sadness and powerlessness only. Motivated by feelings of human solidarity, we call on the competent Polish authorities to immediately provide the refugees stranded in the border area with the necessary humanitarian aid: provide them with hot meals, drinks, medicines, and medical assistance. It is our human responsibility to those in need - regardless of their current and future legal status.
